POLITICAL SIGNS

§701. REGULATIONS.

All political signs promoting or endorsing a candidate for political office shall meet the following requirements:

- A. Political signs shall not be placed on private property without having first having obtained the consent of the owner of the property.
- B. The political signs shall not be placed on the property more than 60 days prior to the applicable election.
- C. All political signs shall be removed from the property within 7 days of the election.

§702. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

Any person who violates any provision of this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$600 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to imprisonment for a term not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues shall constitute a separate offense.
