Park and Recreation

In an effort to continually do our part of reducing debris making its way into our Quittie, the Borough and Borough Authority have increased street sweeping from four to eight sweepings in 2016. ***In order for this to be effective; we need your help!*** It is imperative to have your car off the street by 7:00am the day of your scheduled street sweeping. You can also keep toxins and debris from making their way into the stream by not blowing grass clippings into the street or storm drain, and disposing of cigarette butts, trash and other debris properly. Below is the spring/summer street sweeping schedule:

South Side	Streets running North & South	April 11	May 9	June 13	July 11
South Side	Streets running East & West	April 12	May 10	June 14	July 12

North Side	Streets running East & West	April 14	May 12	June 16	July 14

422 is the dividing line for North & South. Center Street is the dividing line for East & West

The 2016 Bicycle Rodeo will be held Saturday June 11th, 2016

- The rodeo is open to kids ages 12 and under within the Annville-Cleona School District. Participants must wear a helmet and bring their own bicycle. **Pre-registration is suggested** by emailing Sgt. Matthew Rager at mrager@cleonaborough.org with the name and age of the participants.
- The rodeo will begin promptly at 8:30 am with participants having their bicycles registered with the Police Department. Kids will watch a bicycle safety video and then be instructed on proper riding safety. Kids will then finish the program by being escorted through a bicycle safety course.
- Kids that complete the program will be awarded a certificate of completion, prizes and a ticket for a chance to win a free bicycle.

The Rodeo will be cancelled if on the day of the event there is standing water due to rain.

KEEPING OUR BOROUGH BEAUTIFUL

Spring and Summer weather provides seasons of tremendous growth for our grass, trees and shrubs. While we enjoy these seasons during walks through the Borough, we wanted to remind you of the Ordinances regarding your grass, trees and shrubs.

Grass must be kept under six (6) inches in height. Trees shall be kept trimmed and pruned a minimum of eight (8) feet over a sidewalk and fourteen (14) feet over a public highway. Shrubs shall be kept trimmed so they do not hinder or obstruct pedestrians, signs, sidewalks or streets.

Your help in this area is appreciated. Not only do your neighbors appreciate your efforts but emergency vehicles can navigate safely when responding to an emergency. Keeping the line of sight open for motorists prevents accidents.

NORTH CORNWALL GREEN WASTE AGREEMENT

Did you know Cleona Borough has an agreement with North Cornwall to take your green waste? Acceptable items include tree branches (up to 5 inches in diameter), shrubs, twigs, garden materials, weeds, hedge clippings, flowers, plants, ornamental grass (tall & straw-like) and root systems free of dirt. Grass clippings, sod, thatch, fruits and vegetables from trees or plants are not acceptable. Residents who wish to participate will need to come into the Borough office to obtain a residency verification form before proceeding to North Cornwall Township. An annual permit costs \$30.00. A \$5.00 deposit is required for first issuance of key card (refundable at the end of the calendar year with return of the card) or you may use the "Pay-As-You-Go" method of \$4.00 per bag or container at each arrival. Hours of operation are as follows: April 1st-September 30; Monday through Saturday 7:00am-7:00pm and Sunday 10:00-7:00pm. October 1st-March 31; Monday through Saturday 7:00am-5:00pm and Sunday 10:00am-5:00pm. North Cornwall Township is located at 320 South 18th Street. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00am-3:30pm.
