In an effort to continually do our part of reducing debris making its way into our Quittie, the Borough and Borough Authority have increased street sweeping to eight sweepings in 2017. ***In order for this to be effective; we need your help!*** Please mark your calendars for the date the street sweeper will be cleaning your street. We have scheduled street sweepings on the second full week of each month to help you remember to have your car off the street by 7:00am the day of your schedule street sweeping. Thank you for keeping grass clippings out of the street. Please continue to clean up cigarette butts, trash and other debris from your curb, keeping toxins and debris from making their way into the stream. Keeping our Borough Beautiful

Elizabeth Lindsay, Code/Police Councilwomen, continues to encourage residents to keep their properties free from rubbish and debris. Spearheaded by the Mayor and Chief Farneski, the Police Department has taken a more direct role in monitoring minor weed, grass and rubbish/debris in an effort to contain costs. Grass must be kept under six (6) inches in height. Regular weeding stops the weeds from going to seed and spreading not only to other areas of your yard but also your neighbor's yard. Below is the agreement with North Cornwall to help you dispose of your green waste.

Trees shall be kept trimmed and pruned at a minimum of eight (8) feet over a sidewalk and fourteen (14) feet over a public highway. Please keep your shrubs trimmed so they do not hinder signs, streets, or pedestrians walking along your sidewalk. Green waste should be removed within two weeks. If more time is needed, please notify the Borough office.

Your help in this area is appreciated. Not only do your neighbors appreciate your efforts but emergency vehicles can navigate safely when responding to an emergency. Keeping the line of sight open for motorists prevents accidents.

North Cornwall Green Waste Agreement

Did you know Cleona Borough has an agreement with North Cornwall to take your green waste? Acceptable items include tree branches (up to 5 inches in diameter), shrubs, twigs, garden materials, weeds, hedge clippings, flowers, plants, ornamental grass (tall & straw-like) and root systems free of dirt. Grass clippings, sod, thatch, fruits and vegetables from trees or plants are not acceptable. Residents who wish to participate will need to come into the Borough office to obtain a residency verification form before proceeding to North Cornwall Township. An annual permit costs \$30.00. A \$5.00 deposit is required for first issuance of key card (refundable at the end of the calendar year with return of the card) or you may use the "Pay-As-You-Go" method of \$4.00 per bag or container at each arrival. Hours of operation are as follows: April 1st-September 30; Monday through Saturday 7:00am-7:00pm and Sunday 10:00-7:00pm. October 1st-March 31; Monday through Saturday 7:00am-5:00pm and Sunday 10:00am-5:00pm. North Cornwall Township is located at 320 South 18th Street. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00am-3:30pm.

Parking of Recreational Vehicles

With summer vacations and boating outings already in full swing, just a reminder that all recreational vehicles may be stored or parked on the street for a period not to exceed 36 hours for the purpose of loading or unloading. Recreational vehicles are defined as boats & boat trailers, pick-up campers, or coaches, motorized dwellings, tent trailers and the like, and cases or boxes used for transporting recreational equipment.
