Dividing lines are Center Street for East and West and Penn Avenue for North and South. *Please keep your vehicles off the street on your scheduled day.* This makes it easier for the leaf picker to pick up the leaves which in turn helps keep our storm drains clear. The schedule above is subject to change due to weather or holidays. If you still have leaves after leaf clean-up is finished (around December 9<sup>th</sup>), please bag your leaves and call the Borough office to have them picked up.

#### **Lebanon Tire Collection**

Tires provide an excellent habitat for mosquitoes, particularly the Asian Tiger Mosquito, a potential vector of the Zika virus. In response to this potential hazard, the Lebanon County West Nile Virus program is conducting a one-day tire collection on Thursday, November 10, 2016, to promote mosquito habitat removal at the Lebanon Expo Center from 8:00am to 12:00pm.

This program is open to persons living in Lebanon County. There is no pre-registration for this event. Four regular/auto or 1 large tire can be taken for free from each individual so long as space is available. Any tire with an inner rim diameter of 15 inches or less is considered regular/auto. Tires must be off the rim, drained of water, unburned and not excessively dirty. Please bring proof of address; (driver's license, phone bill etc) with you on the day of the collection. Please note; space is limited!

## North Cornwall Green Waste Agreement

Did you know Cleona Borough has an agreement with North Cornwall to take your green waste? Acceptable items include tree branches (up to 5 inches in diameter), shrubs, twigs, garden materials, weeds, hedge clippings, flowers, plants, ornamental grass (tall & straw-like) and root systems free of dirt. Grass clippings, sod, thatch, fruits and vegetables from trees or plants are not acceptable. Residents who wish to participate will need to come into the Borough office to obtain a residency verification form before proceeding to North Cornwall Township. An annual permit costs \$30.00. A \$5.00 deposit is required for first issuance of key card (refundable at the end of the calendar year with return of the card) or you may use the "Pay-As-You-Go" method of \$4.00 per bag or container at each arrival. Hours of operation are as follows: April 1st-September 30; Monday through Saturday 7:00am-7:00pm and Sunday 10:00-7:00pm. October 1st-March 31; Monday through Saturday 7:00am-5:00pm and Sunday 10:00am-5:00pm. North Cornwall Township is located at 320 South 18th Street. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00am-3:30pm.
