STREET SWEEPING



Listed below is Cleona's street sweeping schedule for April through July, 2018. For this program to be effective, *please have your car off the street by 7:00am the day of your scheduled street sweeping. As a reminder our street sweeping schedule starts the second Monday of each month.* Our Public Work's team is also working by inspecting storm drains and monitoring the streets, picking up debris to keep our streams and streets looking beautiful. You can help your Borough Public Work's Department by keeping your curb line clear of debris and weeds.

STREETS

Sam Wengert, Councilman in charge of Streets, is preparing to survey the Borough for sidewalks that need to be repaired or replaced due to deterioration. The Borough is respectfully requesting you replace or repair your sidewalk if you are notified by letter. PennDot must be contacted prior to any sidewalk repair if you live along Penn Avenue. A sidewalk permit may be obtained from the Borough office for \$25.00 which includes an inspection.

DOGS AND CATS

We wish to make you aware that there are ordinances and state laws regarding your dogs and cats. All dogs and cats are never allowed to run at large. Governor Wolf also signed into law Act 10 in June of 2017 which strengthens Pennsylvania's animal cruelty laws most notably new tethering laws. Among other regulations a dog cannot be tethered for longer than 30 minutes in temperatures above 90 or below 32 degrees Fahrenheit. Please clean up after your pets and always carry a bag to dispose of waste properly.

KEEPING THE BOROUGH BEAUTIFUL

Spring is taking its good old time getting here but once it does, the growing season will be upon us again. Please keep all trash in receptacles that are water tight, with a tight cover and in good condition. Grass should be kept at a maximum of 6" in height and never blown into the street. Keeping your property tidy and free of rubbish prevents rodents from inhabiting your property as well as your neighbor's property. To help you dispose of unwanted items, the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority has a list of things that can be recycled on their website, www.gogltra.org. For the aesthetics of the Borough, please do not store items that need to be discarded outside for any extended period of time. Information on our agreement with North Cornwall to dispose of green waste can be obtained on our website.
