STREET SWEEPING



Listed below is Cleona's street sweeping schedule for July through December. As a reminder our street sweeping schedule starts the second Monday of each month. This service is a vital part of our stormwater management program. ***For this program to be effective, please have your car off the street by 7:00am the day of your scheduled street sweeping.*** We understand that busy schedules tend to help us forget what day our street is being swept. If you are interested in a reminder the day before your scheduled street sweeping through a phone call, e-mail or text, please contact the Borough office.

Our Public Work's team is busy inspecting storm drain and monitoring the street for debris. They are asking you to keep your curb clean of debris and please do not let grass clippings blow into the street. Also, keeping your curb free of weeds helps them with curb painting.

STREETS

Please inspect your sidewalks and curbs this Summer. Sam Wengert, Councilman in charge of Streets, is preparing to survey the Borough for sidewalks that need to be repaired or replaced due to deterioration. The Borough is respectfully requesting you replace or repair your sidewalk or curb if you are notified by letter. PennDot must be contacted prior to any sidewalk repair if you live along Penn Avenue. A sidewalk permit may be obtained from the Borough office for \$25.00 which includes an inspection.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Cleona Police Department and Central Medical will be offering free child safety seat inspections on July 20th and August 17th at the park before each movie. You may also contact Officer Henning to schedule an appointment by sending him an e-mail at rhenning@cleonaborough.org. Officer Henning completed a four-day Child Safety Certification course this Spring and is certified to install child car seats.

DOGS AND CATS

We wish to make you aware that there are ordinances and state laws regarding your dogs and cats. All dogs and cats are never allowed to run at large. Governor Wolf also signed into law Act 10 in June of 2017, which strengthens Pennsylvania's animal cruelty laws most notably new tethering laws. Among other regulations a dog cannot be tethered for longer than 30 minutes in temperatures above 90 or below 32 degrees Fahrenheit. Please clean up after your pets and always carry a bag to dispose of waste properly.

KEEPING THE BOROUGH BEAUTIFUL

Summer is a time when many of us take vacations. However, our properties never do! Please keep all grass to a maximum of 6" in height and your property free of weeds. Grass should never be allowed to blow in the street. Keeping your property tidy and free of rubbish prevents rodents from inhabiting your property and making their way indoors when the temperatures drop! Keep all rubbish/garbage in receptacles that are water tight with a tight cover and in good condition. This is also the time to inspect your property for any exposed or rotted wood that needs replaced or painted.

Trees shall be kept trimmed and pruned at a minimum of eight (8) feet over a sidewalk and fourteen (14) feet over a public highway. Please keep your shrubs trimmed so they do not hinder signs, streets, or pedestrians walking along your sidewalk. Green waste should be removed within two weeks. If more time is needed, please notify the Borough office.

To help you dispose of unwanted items, the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority has a list of items that can be recycled on their website, www.goglra.org. For the aesthetics of the Borough, please do not store items that need to be discarded outside for any extended period of time.
